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		<p>continually refuse to honor God, He will humble us</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• recognize that we are not Christians just because our parents are Christians; we need to trust Jesus for ourselves</li><li>• explain that the Holy Spirit living inside the Christian can produce excellent, godly character as He did in the life of Daniel</li><li>• describe how we must learn to trust God and never allow ourselves to be afraid</li><li>• describe how God continued to protect Daniel because of his loyalty and faith</li><li>• recognize that God will protect us just as He protected Daniel if we trust and obey Him</li></ul>
