General Description

The Golf Facility Director is an employee of Willmar Community Christian School charged with developing a golf curriculum that reaches kids K-12. Community Christian School has a desire to be Minnesota's premiere Christian school with a state recognized golf curriculum.

Program Objective

To impact the lives of young people in the Willmar Community by creating a Christ focused golfing and teaching curriculum at Community Christian School

Specific Responsibilities

Leadership

- Develop and implement a plan in compliance with MSHSL Bylaws that will achieve the vision the school has put forth for golf at CCS.

Player Development

- Recognize and develop the spiritual gifts of each student you teach.
- Lead instruction at golf MSHSL compliant camps.

P.E. Curriculum

- Introduce the sport of golf to all students that show a desire to learn.
- Provide Swing, Short Game, and Putting instruction to students.
- Teach TPI or some similar golf specific fitness.
- Integrate golf into CCS P.E. curriculum.

Operations – Administer CCS Golf Curriculum

- Manage the golf space both physically and financially
- Organize and promote golf clinics and MSHSL compliant camps (CCS students and community)
- Oversee all communications of the CCS teaching and golf program.
- Work with High School Coaches to plan, promote, and implement fundraising events each year to financially support the CCS golf program long term
- Assist AD in ensuring MSHSL compliance within our High School golf program
- Oversee scheduling of Golf Facility usage for open gyms, public use and local school teams.

Other Qualifications

Spiritually, a qualified candidate shall possess characteristics that reflect the following;

- an unreserved acceptance of the school's Statement of Faith
- a strong, clear Christian testimony
- a mature, Godly spirit
- a person of faith and prayer
- a strong knowledge and understanding of Scripture
- an active involvement in the local church
- a servant leader

Professionally, a qualified candidate shall be characterized by the following;

- deep understanding and ability to teach mechanics of a golf swing, putting stroke, short game, course management, and mental toughness.
- effectiveness in being able to see how a student learns and instruct in a way that brings out the most talent in a student.
- demonstration of executive and management skills
- effectiveness in oral and written communication
- deep understanding and empathy for the Christian school and the Christian school movement
- commitment to gender and racial diversity at all levels in the workplace
- evidence of being a team player
- openness to new ideas, initiatives, and concepts in education
- engagement in continuing education and professional development

Personally, a qualified candidate's life shall reflect the following;

- Personal relationship with God through Jesus Christ
- Evidence of spiritual maturity and clear Christian testimony
- Exhibits fruits of the spirit in actions and speech
- Shows humility in dealing with others and boldness with difficult situations
- Exhibits servant leadership qualities with students, faculty and parents
- Person of integrity
- Able to maintain confidentiality
