

School Lunch Unpaid Bill Policy

School lunch is free for all Kindergarten through Twelfth-grade students. One full meal is provided through the state of Minnesota free for each student, and any additional meals, or a la carte items will be charged. Families are responsible for keeping money in their lunch account if their student(s) plan on having extra portions or a la carte items. Families can drop off a check or cash in the school office to add a payment to their lunch account. There is no online payment at this time. If their balance goes negative, they will receive a statement with their balance. Balance-due statements are sent out monthly.

Students will be served lunch even with a negative account. Students grade five and up who are negative in their lunch account will not be allowed to get second helpings, chips or cookies as add-ons to their lunch.
