**SUN Bucks Program**

Information and Data Privacy Notice (Minnesota Statutes 2023, section 13.04 subdivision 2)

SUN Bucks Program Information

Your child may be eligible for SUN Bucks program benefits for summer 2026. The SUN Bucks program is a federal nutrition benefit loaded onto electronic cards for families to purchase food. SUN Bucks is jointly implemented by the Minnesota Department of Education (MDE) and the Minnesota Department of Children, Youth, and Families (DCYF).

To be eligible for SUN Bucks benefits, children must be approved for free or reduced-price meals in one of the following ways:

- Receiving Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Minnesota Family Investment Program (MFIP), Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), Medical Assistance (income requirements apply) or Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR).
- Approved through the Application for Educational Benefits by August 31, 2026.

Data Privacy

To confirm your child's eligibility for SUN Bucks benefits, [name of school] must provide information on you and your child to MDE. In addition, MDE must share some information with DCYF to distribute SUN Bucks benefits. This information includes private data about you or your minor child under the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act.

Community Christian School will provide MDE with the following information:

- Student's name, birthdate, and gender
- Student's State Student ID (created specifically for SUN Bucks)
- Dates in which the student was enrolled in the school
- Parent/guardian's name, phone number, email address, and mailing address
- Student's primary home language

- Student's eligibility for free or reduced-price meals

MDE will provide DCYF with the following information on you and your child:

- Student's name and birthdate
- Student's primary home language
- Parent/guardian's name, phone number, email address, and mailing address

MDE and DCYF will only use your information for determining eligibility, distributing benefits, communicating with you about the SUN Bucks program, and managing and evaluating the SUN Bucks program in Minnesota. Your data will not be used for any other purposes. Only MDE and DCYF staff working on the program or others with legal authority to access your data by a state or federal law will have access to your information.

### Opting Out

If you do not want CCS to share your information with MDE and DCYF, please notify us by 5/5/2026 by taking the following action by emailing the front office at [frontdesk@willmarccs.org](mailto:frontdesk@willmarccs.org). If you do not want your information shared with MDE, we will not share it. If you opt out of sharing your information with MDE and DCYF, you will not receive SUN Bucks benefits because MDE and DCYF will not be able to determine eligibility and know where to mail your SUN Bucks card(s).
