### Make Christian Education a Priority

### Get involved with SCRIP

CCS offers the opportunity for families to use the ShopWithScrip.com program. This program allows you to purchase items you would normally purchase using SCRIP gift cards. ### Apply for Financial Assistance

CCS offers a limited amount of needs based scholarships through FACTS for families that qualify and have a child(ren) K-12<sup>th</sup> grade.
